RE: ADA Wet Set Replaceable TWS Unit – Patent Announcement

Gentlemen:

On Friday, September 3, 2010, ADA Solutions, Inc. (“ADA”) of Chelmsford, Massachusetts, initiated a lawsuit in the Boston Federal Court against Engineered Plastics, Inc. (“Armor-Tile”) and Access Products, Inc. (“Access Tile”) for infringement of ADA Solutions' recently-issued U.S. Patent No. 7,779,581. A copy of the Complaint and the '581 Patent are enclosed for your review. ADA alleges that the Armor-Tile Replaceable Cast in Place and Access Tile Cast in Place Replaceable Tactile Warning Surface (“TWS”) Products offered for sale by Engineered Plastics, Inc. and Access Products, Inc. infringe the '581 patent. ADA also believes that installation of the Armor-Tile and Access Tile Replaceable TWS Products further violates its patent rights.

ADA is the industry leading U.S. Manufacturer of ADAAG Compliant Tactile Warning Surface Products used for Municipal (Curb Ramps), Commercial, Institutional, and Transit Facility Applications throughout North America. ADA strongly values and appreciates the loyal business relationships that have been developed over the years with our many hard working Distributors and Customers and we will continue to work very hard to maintain all of these business relationships far into the future. ADA has built up a loyal following on the strength of offering readily available and innovative TWS Products known for superior performance in addition to our exceptional customer service and very competitive TWS Product pricing. Our Customers and Distributors have come to expect that ADA will always be on the cutting edge of innovation in our industry.

In light of the research and investment required to create new and improved TWS Products, such as the ADA Wet Set Replaceable TWS Product, as well as the effort required to obtain patent protection, ADA felt compelled to enforce its patent rights against infringing companies such as Engineered Plastics, Inc. and Access Products, Inc. Our suit against those companies seeks damages and an order requiring the accused infringers to cease selling infringing TWS Products.

We had hoped that our competitors would, like our potential and actual customers, have honored ADA's intellectual property rights (including U.S. Patent 7,779,581) when selecting a TWS Product for installation on a given Project. Please keep in mind that Replaceable TWS Products that are enjoined as infringing upon ADA's intellectual property rights will, in the end, no longer be replaceable because such non-ADA Replaceable TWS Products will not be available for sale to potential end users and Replaceable TWS Products are not necessarily interchangeable from supplier to supplier.
